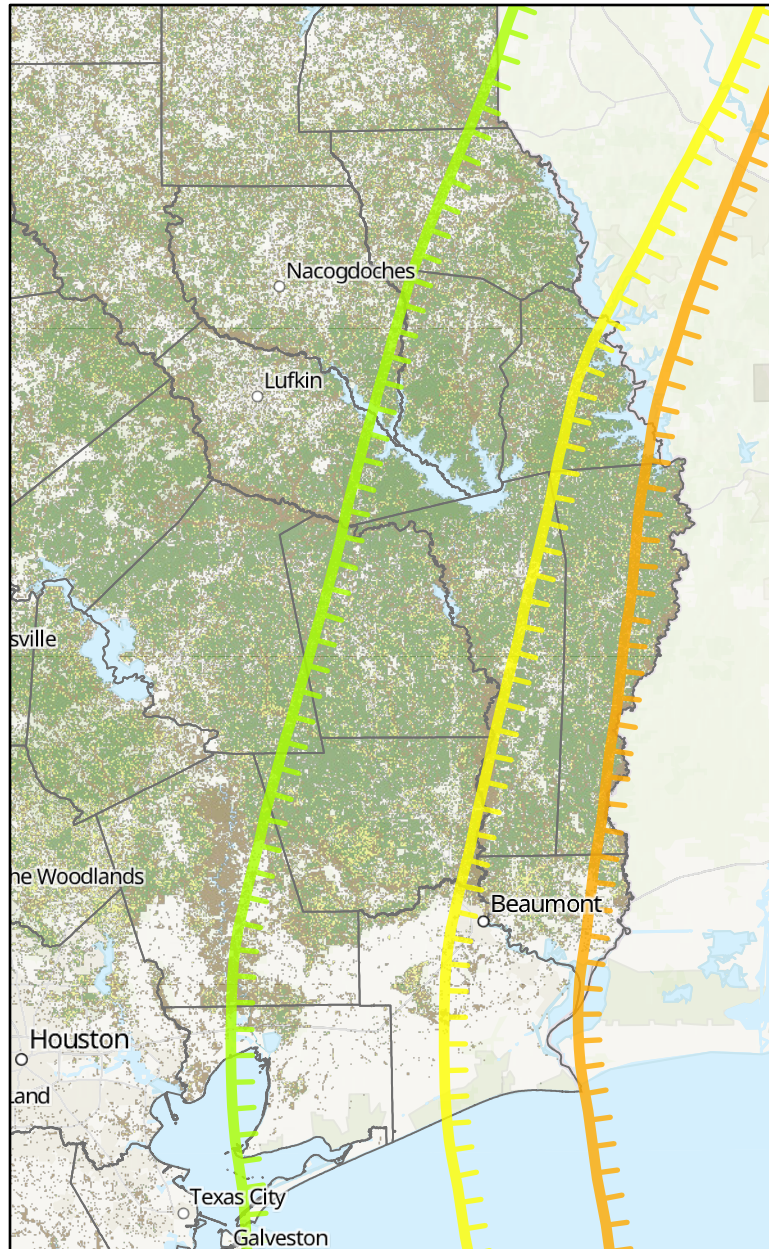


Hurricanes Laura and Delta

Hurricane Laura brought hurricane- and tropical storm-force winds to a small portion of East Texas on August 27th. Hurricane Delta made landfall on October 9th and brought maximum sustained winds of 39 to 57 mph to approximately the same area.

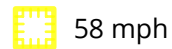
Wind Speed

Hurricane force (Cat-1)

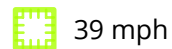

Tropical storm force

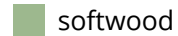

Forest Type



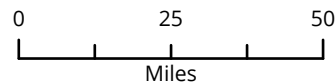
softwood
